- High Learning Curriculum which does not address market needs
- Minimal cooperation between government and High Learning Institutions:
- Education and awareness campaigns in areas of land remediation, waste, chemicals and asbestos management
- Research and innovation in areas of Land remediation, waste, chemicals management and asbestos
- Graduates not taking advantages of job opportunities that exist in the environment
