# INTRODUCTION/BACKGROUND

- The Good Green Deeds Programme is a nationwide environmental programme that proposes a simple but bold blueprint for what we all can do as individuals, organizations, communities and as a nation to bring about the realization of a cleaner and more environmentally presentable country.
- The Programme was launched by the Honarable President, Mr. Cyril Ramaphosa on the 8th of March 2019 in Mdantsane, East London.
- The Programme seeks to change people's attitude, behavior towards responsible management of waste, and keeping their neighborhood's clean, green and safe.

- The Good Green Deeds Programme includes simple, practical steps that every person may perform in day-to-day life that can make a visible difference to the environment. Actions can be practiced at an individual community and corporate levels, for the overall protection of the environment.
- The objective of the Good Green Deeds Programme is a positive drive towards a clean South Africa which is free of litter and illegal dumps.

# GAUTENG GGD PROGRAMME

- In response to President Cyril Ramaphosa's call on all South Africans to take charge and clean up their living environment, Gauteng Premier, David Makhura together with MECs from different departments launched the "Gauteng Good Green Deeds" programme.
- The Premier launched the programme on the 8th of March 2019 in Sharpville Township.
- The launch was followed with massive clean-up campaigns, which were rolled out to the rest of Emfuleni Local Municipality, the campaign has been designed to clean up sidewalks, storm-water drainage, open spaces and raise awareness.

- Future planned programmes to support the GGD programme include the youth jobs in waste, waste reuse and innovation, graduates, alien vegetation species control and wetlands rehabilitation.

- The Department assists them with tools, equipment, training and materials.



2 X Major Clean-ups per corridor (West, East, Central, South and North)

To date (since the GGD launch): 4 Major Clean-ups were conducted in the following areas;

West Corridor: Plans in place for Q 3-4

East Corridor: Wattville Township Clean-ups (1) Central Corridor: Alexandra Township Clean-up (1)

South Corridor: Boipatong Clean-up (1), Evaton Clean-up

(1) & Tshepisong Clean-up (1)

North Corridor: Mamelodi (1) & Nelmapius (1) Townships

Major clean-ups utilises a combination of heavy machine (TLBs/Trucks) & EPWP participants (work opportunities)


