

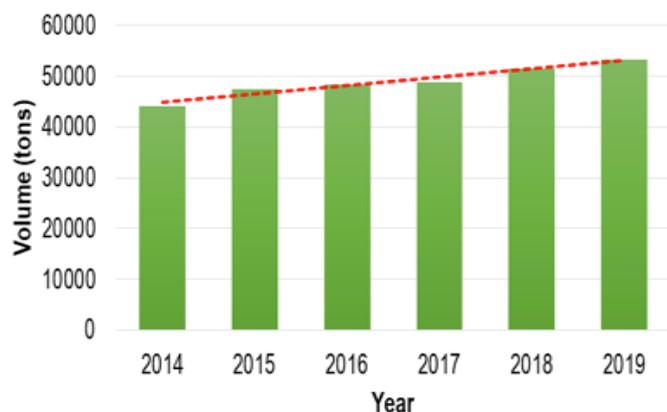
# 2019 Health Care Risk Waste Treatment Figures

In 2019 there were 20 licensed health care risk waste (HCRW) treatment facilities in operation, utilising either incineration, non-burn or both technologies as indicated in the table below.

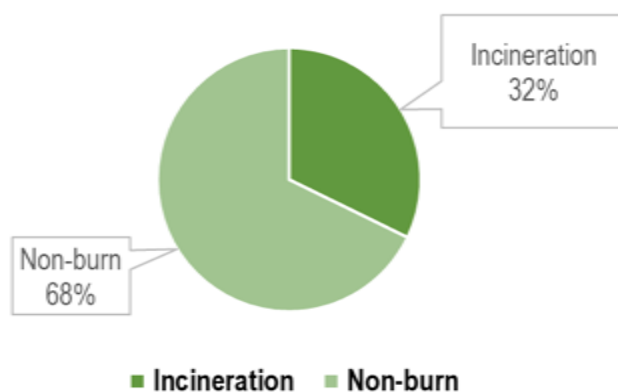

Based on monthly reports submitted to the Department of Environmental Affairs, the total volume of waste treated at the licensed facilities was approximately 53300 tonnes, indicating an annual increase of approximately 3.5%. The majority (66%) of the waste was treated by means of non-burn technology, the remaining 34% was treated by means of incineration.
